Biographical Sketch. Lanford Wilson (1937-2011) was born in Lebanon Missouri to Ralph and Violetta Tate Wilson. In 1942 his parents divorced, and he and his mother moved to Springfield, Missouri, where she took a job in a garment factory. When Wilson was 11 years old his mother married Walt E. Lenhard, a farmer from Ozark, Missouri.

When Wilson died in 2011 at age 73, he left his entire manuscript collection to the University of Missouri. Lanford Wilson (April 13, 1937 – March 24, 2011) was an American playwright. His work, as described by *The New York Times*, was "earthy, realist, greatly admired [and] widely performed." Wilson helped to advance the Off-Off-Broadway theater movement with his earliest plays, which were first produced at the *Caffe Cino* beginning in 1964. He was one of the first playwrights to move from Off-Off
