When the vortex of the Arctic is strong, it is well defined, there is a single vortex with a jet stream that is "well constrained" near the polar front, and the Arctic air is well contained. When the northern vortex weakens, which it generally does, it will break into two or more smaller vortices, the strongest of which are near Baffin Island, Canada, and the other over northeast Siberia.
